# PUBLIC NOTICE

### SENSITIZATION WORKSHOPS AND REGISTRATION OF YOUTH, WOMEN AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITY AT NATIONAL IRRIGATION BOARD

The National Irrigation Board (hereinafter referred to as “Board”) is a Government parastatal, under the Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation, established in 1966 by an Act of Parliament, Chapter 347 of the Laws of Kenya, and whose mandate is the development, promotion and management of all national irrigation schemes in the country.

Pursuant to Sec 157 (10) of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, PPADA 2015 (Act), the Board wishes to advise the youth, women and persons with disability that it allocates and shall continue to allocate at least 30% of its procurement value to them in every financial year. The Board therefore request this group to regularly check the Board’s website: <http://www.nib.or.ke/tenders> or GoK’s e-procurement portal, <http://www.supplier.treasury.go.ke> for tender opportunities as and when they are published in order to participate as required.

Further and pursuant to Sec 71 of the PPDA 2015, the Board is continuously updating its list of registered suppliers, contractors, consultants in various categories including those registered by the National Treasury in the youth, women and persons with disability categories. Subsequently, the Board will undertake sensitization and registration of the said groups in its countywide schemes and Head office as indicated in the schedule below:

1. Application letter addressed to the General Manager, requesting to be registered by the Board as a supplier/contractor/service provider/consultant (specify your area of interest).
2. Certified Company registration certificate or business name.
3. Certified and Valid Youth, Women or Persons with Disability Certificate.
4. Certified Director's identification documents.
5. Certified Latest CR 12 certificate for limited companies
6. I-Tax PIN certificate and valid tax compliance certificate
7. Detailed latest company profile.
8. Certified Audited accounts or proof of holding a bank account.
9. Certified National Construction Authority certificate for those seeking consideration for construction works.

Other suppliers, contractors, consultants NOT registered in the youth, women and persons with disability categories SHOULD only submit application (without attending the sensitization workshops) for registration by submitting the above listed document except Valid Youth, Women or Persons with Disability Certificate (AGPO Certificate).
