Note and adhere to the following:

1. The buyers are encouraged to view the consignment at NCPB Voi Deport during working days between 10.00am and 4.00pm. For this, they will liaise with the deport manager
2. To qualify, one must bid for a Minimum of 1000 x 50 kgs ( 50,000 kgs)
3. The buyer will be required to pay within fourteen (14) days from the date of the letter acceptance of offer, failure to pay within the stipulated fourteen (14) days will render the buyer(s) offer invalid
4. It should be noted that the maize will be considered sold upon payment.
5. The buyer will be expected to collect the bought consignment within a maximum of seven days after payment. ~~In case~~ In case of any delay to collect the quoted consignment ~~ion~~ beyond seven days, the buyer shall meet storage and any other incidental charges to NCPB.
